You may be eligible for a 50% cost share rebate (\$125 max rebate per producer) on purchase of approved herbicides to manage vegetation in fence lines and spot treatment of non-native invasive plants in stream buffer areas. This program is restricted to stream exclusion areas installed to protect water quality. Funding is provided by the Bedford County Board of Supervisors and the Peaks of Otter Soil and Water Conservation District. Examples of eligible herbicides for this program:

Remedy Ultra	Grazon Next
Crossbow	2,4-D plus Dicamba
Glyphosate (ex. Roundup)	Cimarron Plus

If you have more than one farm that you are applying for herbicide, please list them out individually in the table. No applicant will be awarded more than \$125 cost share.

Each participant will agree to spot checks scheduled in advance with permission of participant to verify compliance with program rules. Participants also will be required to submit a report documenting the date and approximate feet of fence treated. If treatments cannot be made before onset of cold weather in 2021, treatments may be delayed to 2022 growing season.
