Bedford County joins Gauntlet for 2021

Bedford County businesses both aspiring and existing are now eligible to participate in Virginia's largest business competition, The Gauntlet.



The program is held on Tuesdays from 6-7:30 p.m. virtually, now through May 27. Participants will connect with hundreds of Gauntlet alumni, industry experts, investors and community leaders to build on their business idea or plan. Classes include business development and planning, financial analysis, operations, marketing, sales and retention, among others. ElectricCoMarket underway on Depot Street in Bedford

Joining The Gauntlet for business development and mentorship is a new business in town. ElectricCoArt

is under development at 207 East Depot Street in downtown Bedford. The owner, Wendy Witt, plans to encompass three different businesses:

- ElectricCoMarket, a 3,100+ sf market place of approximately 25 vendors, to include William Mauser, blacksmith and woodsmith;
- ElectricCoBistro, a casual dining bistro featuring creative comfort foods with an inviting atmosphere;
- ElectricCoGallery, an approximately 3,000 sf contemporary art gallery.

"I'm really looking forward to meeting like-minded entrepreneurs and hope to create relationships to help with marketing and HR and employment expertise," Wendy Witt explains, regarding her enthusiasm to join The Gauntlet program. "We intend to create a space that will be exciting to Bedford and well beyond...looking forward to adding to the destination aspects of our beautiful town."



Wondering what's available to businesses in 2021?

The **SBA offers** several different <u>relief options</u> to help businesses, nonprofits, and faith-based organizations recover from the impacts of COVID-19.

PPP First Draw Loans: If you have not received a PPP loan before, First Draw PPP Loans may be available to you.

PPP Second Draw Loans: If you have previously received PPP loan, certain businesses are eligible for a Second Draw PPP Loan.

COVID-19 Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDL): This loan provides economic relief to small businesses and nonprofit organizations that are currently experiencing a temporary loss of revenue.

The **Business Development Centre** in Lynchburg has loan funds available to help small businesses.

Business Development Centre Loan Fund: Loans range from \$1,000 to \$35,000 for independently owned businesses with 50 or fewer employees.

Venture for Enterprising Women Loan Program: Loans range from \$1,000 to \$35,000 for independently women owned businesses with 51% majority ownership and 50 or fewer employees.

Continued unemployment claims drop

During the week of January 16, 109 initial unemployment insurance claims were filed in the Central Virginia Local Workforce Development Area (LWDA) for Bedford County residents. That number is down from 115 the previous week. Bedford County's continued claims dropped from 459 to 427.
