# Things Government" tour for AP Government students

In February nearly 60 Advanced Placement (AP) Government students, from all three public high schools, were treated to a very special Bedford ONE Tour. This tour was strategically designed to highlight some of the local government services the county is responsible for providing its citizens.

The day began with an official welcome from

County administrator Robert Hiss, who shared demographic information about the county, some of his main responsibilities, and explained a little about the county budget and how that is calculated based on the tax rate.

Students were broken up into several groups and rotated between three designated areas, as different departments presented information about their respective roles. The Governor's Agriculture and Forestry Industries Development Fund (AFID) Infrastructure Grant Program is focused on awarding reimbursable grants primarily for capital projects at new and existing food hubs, farmers' markets, commercial kitchens, and other value-added VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES

facilities such as those used for processing and packaging meats, dairy products, produce, or other Virginia-grown products.

Applications must be made by a political subdivision of the Commonwealth, typically Counties and Cities, but also Towns, Industrial and Economic Development Authorities, or Planning District Commissions. Eligible groups must submit applications for grants of *up to* \$50,000 by**5 p.m. on May 6, 2024.**
